

What can I do to reduce my dog's shedding?

Our hydro-surge bath system, along with our special conditioner will help reduce excessive shedding. We can also perform a technique called "carding" on short-haired dogs. *Skin and Coat for Dogs and Cats*, a supplement available on our website, also helps reduce shedding.

My older pet has trouble getting around. Is there anything I can do to help?

Our hydro-surge bath gives your pet an initial 10 minutes of massage, followed by 10 more minutes during their conditioning treatment. This usually gives pets some relief for arthritic joints. For maximum benefit, we recommend regular hydro-surge treatments in addition to the nutritional supplement, *Agility*, available on our website. We've seen significant improvement in many pets who follow this treatment regiment.

Is there any way I can keep my dog from scratching itself all the time?

Scratching can be the result of a number of problems, so pinpointing the culprit is top priority. The staff at Cathy's Pet Salon & Spa can easily spot and help eliminate a flea problem. Another culprit could be poor nutrition or allergies. On our website, you'll find *Life's Abundance Premium Health Foods*, containing only fresh, natural, wholesome ingredients formulated to provide 100% complete nutrition in accordance with AAFCO feeding protocol. How soon and how often should I have my pet groomed?

Your dog can be bathed or groomed every 2 weeks, *if* the proper supplies are used. At Cathy's Pet Salon & Spa we use all-natural shampoos which don't strip all the dog's natural oils. The shampoo is followed by a conditioning treatment for the skin and coat. A shower of clean water makes sure all the shampoo and conditioner is thoroughly rinsed out of the coat. Any shampoo or conditioner left in the dog's coat can lead to hot spots and itchy skin.

Cats don't need to be bathed as frequently as dogs, *but* my persian is bathed every 7-10 days because of an allergic human! She's also eating *Life's Abundance Cat Food* with supplement, and takes *Skin and Coat Formula* occasionally. (She thinks what ever the dogs eats she should get!)

How can I help my dog's bad breath?

We recommend and use Oxyfresh oral hygiene solution for pets. Simply add 1 ounce to 1 quart of their drinking water and in approximately 3 weeks your pet's breath should start smelling fresher. There's also an oral gel which complements the solution for an overall healthier mouth.

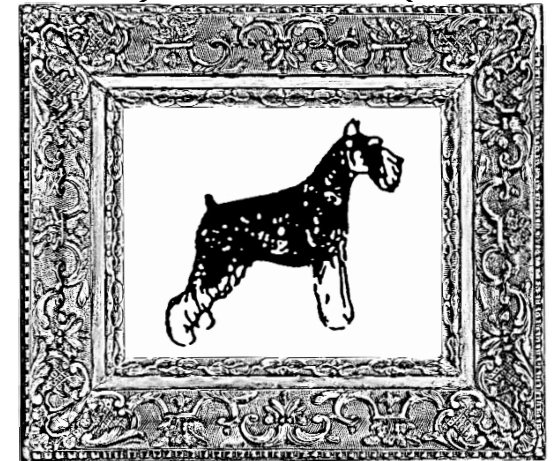
